

Phase 2 survey of 40 Acre Field, Stanmore Country Park
Denis Vickers and Steve Bolsover, 9th August 2013

Five quadrats, each 1 metre square, were placed in the southern part of 40 Acre Field. The northern part had a clearly different plant community and would require a separate survey. Quadrats were placed at:

The quadrats were marked with sawn off metal road pins which were left *in situ* so that by use of a metal detector the original quadrats should be findable in the future.
